



**Contract for SMS Dominican Republic Mission Trip
February 27th – March 7th, 2009**

I wish to enroll _____ (*child's full name*) in St. Margaret's School's 2009 Mission Trip to the Dominican Republic for February 27-March 7, 2009.

The fee, excluding immunizations, will be approximately \$1,650. I agree to pay the stated fee and such other charges as the above student may incur.

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 (Make checks payable to St. Margaret's School), to be applied towards the fee, is enclosed with this signed contract. (This is due by Friday, October 17, 2008) I understand that the fee is due in full by Friday, November 14, 2008.

I agree to accept the following terms and conditions of this enrollment contract:

1. The fee includes program cost to support the work of Orphanage Outreach, Inc., lodging, meals, flight, and recreation while in the Dominican Republic.
2. Immunizations (Hepatitis A and Malaria) will be required. (not included in fee)
3. Travel arrangements will be made by St. Margaret's School and Delta Airlines. The group will take a bus to Richmond and fly out of Richmond International airport.
4. Parents/Guardians who withdraw a student for any reason and parents/guardians of students who are absent or dismissed for any reason while on the trip are not entitled to a refund of the fee, either total or partial.
5. Since the School is responsible for the development of its students, both academically and socially, it must and does reserve the unconditional right to suspend or dismiss any student whose progress or conduct is deemed, at the School's sole discretion, to be unsatisfactory. Should a student be dismissed from this program for any reason, the parents/guardians will be notified and advised that the student will be escorted by one of the Program's Directors to an airport for return to the United States at the earliest possible convenience. Travel expenses in this case will be borne by the parents or guardians of the dismissed student.
6. Possession or consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs in any form will result in immediate dismissal from the program.
7. The student understands that he or she is to abide by all the rules and regulations set out in the Student Handbook for St. Margaret's School. For all purposes, the student is considered *on school property* while on this trip.
8. The School does not assume any responsibility for damage to or loss of a student's personal property.
9. The School does not provide health or life insurance for a student enrolled in this Program. Parents/Guardians should check with their own insurance company to assure that their family policy covers family members in need of medical treatment abroad or while in flight.



10. The School reserves the right unilaterally to cancel the program for any reason including economic, political, or social considerations, including the safety and welfare of the students. In such an event, the School will partially refund the cost, excluding flight costs and money already paid to Orphanage Outreach, Inc.
